



Free COVID-19 Testing at Union City Family Center

The New Haven Unified School District has partnered with the California Department of Public Health to offer COVID-19 testing. To get started, [please click here](#). You only need to register once and each time you test, it will take no longer than 5 minutes.

Testing is not required, but highly encouraged.

- This program has two different types of testing: BinaxNOW (rapid antigen tests with results in under 30-minutes) and PCR tests (results in 48-72 hours).
- Pre-registration is recommended and collects necessary information and consent.
- All questions included in registration are required for California State public health reporting. Please note this program is free for all participants.
- Information and test results are only shared with the testing site, lab partners and local/state health departments. It is not used for any other purposes.
- All results are shared electronically with the contact information provided during registration.

We'll be testing Monday-Friday between the hours of 1:00-4:00 at the [Union City Family Center](#).
