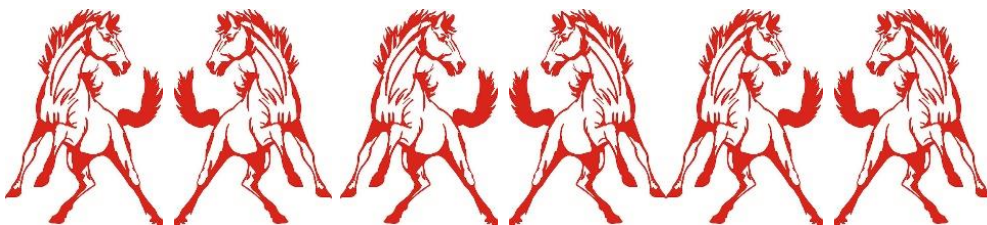
Logan Athletics Update!
