Board Approves New District Logo

In the spring of 2021, the Board began the process of redesigning the District's logo. The Board partnered with a firm that worked in tandem with the Communication and Advocacy Board Committee to develop sample logos with inspiration coming from student submissions and a review of District initiatives and prior survey data. The initial set of logos was reviewed by the committee and the design firm was given feedback on changes that committee would like to see.

The three draft logos were also shared with the community in the form of a survey. Over 550 stakeholders gave input on the three designs evaluating their originality, representation of the district, and how well the designs reflected key ideals. Community feedback was used to revise the logos further.

On Tuesday night, the Board reviewed the three final logo designs submitted by the committee and made its final selection:



This logo is student inspired as multiple students submissions incorporated a lightbulb as a reflection of learning and innovation.
